

# LeCroy Scholars Program

## AMOUNT

High school students will receive full tuition and books for up to four semesters. Students currently attending any of the seven colleges of DCCCD will receive full tuition and books for the remainder of their two-year program. (Fall and spring semesters only.)

## DEADLINE

**First Friday in April**

Applicants must submit a complete packet with all required paperwork. Submissions postmarked or received by this date will be considered.

## BASIC REQUIREMENTS

### GPA 3.0

**ESSAY** One page minimum, typed essay describing why you want to be a LeCroy Scholar, include your leadership and academic qualifications

### LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

High school students: counselor or principal

College students: faculty member or counselor

**PREREQUISITE** Strong leadership record must be demonstrated by involvement in academic, church, and/or community based activities; Assumption of leadership in clubs, athletics, extracurricular activities; Strong academic record typically underscored by activities such as honors society involvement, academic club memberships or the selection of academically rigorous course work

**COLLEGE** Any college of DCCCD

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## DESCRIPTION

The LeCroy Scholars Program was created in 1988 by DCCCD Foundation Board Member **Mike A. Myers** to recognize Dr. R. Jan LeCroy, Chancellor of the DCCCD from 1981 to 1988, for his exemplary leadership in education and in the community. Outstanding leadership and scholarship are two of the hallmarks of Dr. LeCroy's tenure and are the main requirements of the LeCroy Scholars Program. Jan LeCroy and Mike Myers will act as mentors to the LeCroy Scholars.

## FULL REQUIREMENTS

**Applicant must:**

1. Be enrolled or plan to enroll at one of the seven Dallas County Community Colleges
2. Exemplify outstanding leadership
3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA at the end of each semester
4. Successfully complete a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester
5. Recipients must also commit to attend planned LeCroy Scholars events, which are outlined in the LeCroy scholarship commitment form
6. Failure to meet the requirements above could result in a reduction or loss of scholarship benefits

**Submit the following to the DCCCD Foundation:**

2. Completed [LeCroy Scholars application](#)
3. One page minimum, typed essay describing why you want to be a LeCroy Scholar. Include your leadership and academic qualifications, and state why you are applying for this scholarship
4. Letter of recommendation. High school students: counselor or principal. College students: faculty member or counselor
5. Official high school transcript or transcript from your DCCCD college
6. Personal photograph (Required to complete application, not a factor in the selection process).
